



Mon: 1.74 metres tall or 174cm

Tues: Incorrect because the digits move 2 places to the right, the answer should be 7.156

Weds: £2.80 (round up the cheese sandwich to £2 and then subtract the 5p at the end)

Thurs: 1.8 + 0.9 - 2.7 is the only correct calculation

Fri: 84 people


Mon: 360 minutes

Tues: Correct because the digits move 2 places to the left.

Fri: Kye because he worked 10 hours while Dave worked 9 hours.



Mon: 44 years old

Tues: Incorrect because the digits move 3 places to the right. The correct answer is 8.69
